<p>As a result of the exponential growth of Bigwinboard, now recognised as one of the leading independent European iGaming news sites, many game providers reach out to us asking us to review their games. It's a risky move as we've become known to be slayers of slots we don't like, although many providers do in fact appreciate the honest input expressed in our reviews.</p>

<p>The other day we got a message from Pragmatic Play asking us to check out their products, which initially didn't trigger much excitement to be very frank. In our view, Pragmatic Play has for a long time been a generic freak of a provider, failing to evoke one's curiosity. But just like is the case with Red Tiger, or Push Gaming, that might be about to change.</p>

<p>The company was originally launched in 2007 as TopGame but was rebranded, and renamed Pragmatic Play in 2024, to mark a new beginning after having been involved in some minor controversies. Things have indeed changed, and today we see a growing company represented on all the major online casinos and an EGR Software Rising Star 2024 award winner.</p>

<p>At first glance, the game does not appear to stick out in any particular way. It's got the typical characteristics of a Pragmatic slot and a setup of 5 reels, 3 rows and 25 pay lines. The game takes bets ranging from $\lt;0.25$ up to a maximum of $\lt;125$ and is delivered with a 96.53% theoretical return to player. It should be pointed out, however, that Pragmatic, just like Play'n GO, Novomatic, and many other providers, allow operators (casinos) to choose a different RTP setting, so always make sure to take a look at which version you're playing. It could potentially be as low as 90.04%.</p>
